Park Directive No. 2045

OUTSIDE CATERING

No person, group, or organization will be permitted to bring their own food when using Lodge or Restaurant facilities (such as covered dish suppers), and outside caterers will not be permitted to cater parties or other events at these facilities. Our Restaurants are prepared to provide these services and, in addition, we cannot take responsibility for possible food poisoning from food we did not prepare.

Catering may be permitted in overnight group facilities when park facilities cannot provide the service and groups do not wish to prepare their own food. In such instances, the food must be served in the group facility dining hall, the use of which must be in accord with current fee rates.

In event groups wish to arrange for complete catering service when not using overnight group facilities and the park cannot provide the service, the park superintendent may authorize such catering specifically for such groups. In such instances, a specific area will be designated for caterer to set up, and trash and garbage and other rules prescribed to insure that park facilities are not abused and other park users are not inconvenienced.

Under no circumstances will caterers be permitted to solicit such services on park property or to operate a retail concession by collecting from individuals being served.
