Park Directive No. 3080

HORSEBACK RIDING

It shall be unlawful to ride or take horses and other riding animals onto park areas not specifically designated as trails for horses by sign or by verbal permission from park officials. Such animals may be ridden on park streets or roads unless such streets or roads are marked with signs prohibiting horseback riding.

Horses shall not be ridden or taken onto swimming beaches, parking areas, camping and picnic areas, nor within 100 feet of any public activity or building utilized for eating, sleeping, swimming, boat rental or sale of any items other than a horseback riding service such as stable area.
