Park Directive 3160

SWIMMING AREAS AND POOLS

Swimming in any of the streams or lakes within state parks boundaries is prohibited except at such areas which are designated and marked as authorized swimming places. When such places are defined by signs or markers, swimming beyond such defined limits is prohibited.

Pool regulations and hours of operation are posted at all state park swimming pools or beaches. Persons not abiding by such regulations will not be permitted to remain.

Life Guards on duty at state park swimming facilities are charged with the responsibility of enforcing rules and regulations and of safeguarding participants. Any person refusing to comply with a Life Guard's instructions shall be ejected from the premises without refund on the swimming fee.

The use of alcoholic beverages or drugs in swimming areas is prohibited.
